Key Topic 3: To what extent did the Republic recover after 1923?? a) I can dissect the composition of The Weimar Constitution, the main political divisions, the role of the army and how this impacted recovery. a) I can assess the significance of the political disorder, 1919–23, the economic crises and hyper-inflation along with the occupation of the Ruhr. Key Topic 4: What were the achievements of the Weimar period? a) I can provide detailed descriptions of the cultural achievements of the Weimar period under Stresemann. Key Topic 1: What did the Nazi Party stand for in the 1920s? a) I can discuss the early years of the Nazi Party, their ideas and methodologies and the roles of their key figures. Key Topic 2: Why did the Nazis have little success before 1930? a) I can link the impact of the Weimar Republic and other factors to the lack of support for the Nazi party before 1930. Key Topic 3: Why was Hitler able to become Chancellor by 1933? a) I can discuss the impact of the great depression and other reasons why there was increased support for Hitler and the Nazis in the 1930s; which eventually led to his chancellorship. Key Topic 4: How did Hitler consolidate his power in 1933–34? a) I can explain how Hitler used the Reichstag Fire, the election of 1933, the Enabling Act and other factors to consolidate his power.
