Grades will not be given at this time.</p> <p>EXAMPLES OF FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT TASKS, THAT WILL BE USED THIS TERM IN END OF UNIT TESTS:</p> <p>Writing task in style required for the examination. Creative writing task according to the topics. Presentation Produce a video. Multiple choice activity (which requires challenge, not obvious answers) Projects to be given to the students about the topic done.</p> <p>Summative assessment at end of units studied.
